## Recycling Guidelines

- As per New Jersey State Law and Chapter 614 of the Code of the Township of Nutley, recycling is **MANDATORY** for all property owners, tenants, residents and businesses.
- It is the responsibility of the resident to recycle according to the listed guidelines.
- Recyclables are to be placed in the correct container at curbside **no earlier than 5:00 PM the night before or no later than 7:00 AM the day of collection.**
- You can help avoid missed pickups by not placing your recyclables next to trees, telephone poles, parked cars or other obstructions and by having the material at the curb for collection at the proper times and in the proper recycling containers.
- Recyclables may not be placed in the street.

## Commingled Recycling

### METAL, GLASS & PLASTIC

Aluminum and tin cans  
Glass bottles and jars  
Plastic containers with #1 thru #7 on the bottom (such as food, beverage, yogurt, detergent and shampoo bottles)

### CARTONS

Cream, Milk and Soy Milk  
Juice and Individual Juice  
Soup and Broth  
Wine

### MIXED PAPER

Books  
Junk mail  
Letters and envelopes  
Magazines and catalogs  
Newspapers  
Office and colored paper  
Paper bags  
Paperboard (such as cereal, pizza and tissue boxes)  
Phone books

### CARDBOARD

All corrugated cardboard boxes (cut into 18 inch pieces)

### SHREDDED PAPER

Place into clear plastic garbage bags

#### \* COMMINGLED RECYCLING - NOT ACCEPTED

- Recycling containers weighing more than 35 pounds or placed in any plastic bags
- Drinking or window glass
- Plastic shopping bags
- Flower pots
- Light bulbs
- Styrofoam
- Other types of plastics

#### \* PAPER AND CARDBOARD RECYCLING - NOT ACCEPTED

- Recycling containers weighing more than 35 pounds or placed in any plastic bags
- Paper plates, cups or towels
- Wax coated cardboard
- Soiled or food contaminated papers or cartons
- Cardboard not broken down, larger than 18 inches or with styrofoam inserts

**As of August 1, 2015 Electronics are no longer picked up curbside!**

- Garbage and Vegetative Waste Collection**
- Bulk Metal "White Goods"**  
Bulk metal "White Goods" (such as refrigerators, dryers, washers, ranges, air conditioners, etc.) will be picked up by the garbage collector on THURSDAYS and will be recycled. For the safety of our children, please REMOVE DOORS before placing items curbside! All requests must be received by Wednesday, 2:00 PM.
- Bulk Items**  
Bulk items (such as furniture, mattresses, box springs, rugs), will be picked up by the garbage collector on WEDNESDAYS.

## Items That Can Be Dropped Off

The following items may be dropped off Monday thru Friday between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM.

### Town Hall, 2nd Floor - Engineering Dept.

#### Compact Fluorescent Lightbulbs

CFLs are now accepted for recycling.

- Tube and Incandescent bulbs are not accepted!
- Lightbulbs cannot be broken
- Lightbulbs must be sealed separately

### Municipal Garage - 1 Cortland St.

#### Vehicle Batteries

Vehicle batteries can be dropped off in the designated bin.

#### Used Motor Oil

Bring used motor oil to any service station that works on cars or it can be dropped off at the Municipal Garage.

## Tire Recycling

#### Car Tires

Residents may dispose of TWO (2) tires (without rims) at a time.

# Vegetative Waste and Leaf Collection



**As of May 1, 2015 Vegetative Waste and Yard Debris Regulations have changed and are picked up by the Garbage Collector!**

- LOOSE LEAVES ARE NOT TO BE PLACED INTO THE STREET AS PER TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE AND NEW JERSEY STATE STORMWATER REGULATIONS
- IF YOU ARE USING A LANDSCAPER, REMOVAL IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LANDSCAPER!

## Vegetative Waste and Leaves (Collection Period: April 15 thru December 15)

Township-wide pickup by the garbage collector will be on **WEDNESDAYS**, excluding holidays

- All leaves, vegetation and yard debris must be placed in BROWN BIO-DEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS or CONTAINER
- Plastic bags of any type or containers weighing more than fifty (50) pounds WILL NOT be collected!

### Grass Clippings and Yard Debris

Place in CONTAINER or BROWN BIO-DEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS (5-6 bags will be picked up at a time). If you are using a landscaper, removal is the responsibility of the landscaper.

### Grasscycling - "Cut It and Leave It" Program

Grasscycling is the natural recycling of grass by leaving clippings on the lawn when mowing. Grass clippings decompose quickly, returning valuable nutrients back into the soil. For more information on Grasscycling please visit [www.nutleynj.org](http://www.nutleynj.org).

## Christmas Trees

January 2 thru January 12, 2018

Residents with real Christmas trees may leave them at curbside for pickup by the DPW during this time period. Trees must be free of ornaments and stands and cannot be bagged.

### Tree Branches

Loose wood, brush, tree limbs and branches must be cut into four (4) foot lengths and tied in bundles, weighing no more than fifty (50) pounds each.

### Fall Leaf Collection

**Wednesdays (October 15 thru December 15)**

All leaves must be placed in a CONTAINER or BROWN BIO-DEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS and will be picked up curbside during this time period.



**DO NOT place Vegetative Waste in your Blue Recycling Bin!**

## Composting & Compost Bins

Composting is nature's way of recycling organic materials back into the soil in order for the cycle of life to continue.

## Be Safe With Hazardous Waste

Products used for cleaning, home improvements, automobile maintenance, and lawn and garden care contain ingredients that can harm human health and the environment. Properly disposing of these hazardous products will keep our community safe and clean.

### Paint

#### LATEX PAINT

Let paint can dry out and dispose of with your regular garbage.

#### OIL-BASED PAINT

Dispose of at one of the ECUA's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Days.

### Cooking Oil and Grease

Help our sewer system flowing! Place cooled cooking oil, poultry and meat fats in a sealed non-recyclable container and discard with your regular garbage.



## Rechargeable Batteries

NiCd/Rechargeable batteries ranging from the small 1.5V AAA batteries, to cell phone, laptop and power tool batteries can be disposed of at one of the ECUA's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Days.

**Alkaline batteries are no longer considered hazardous waste and can be disposed with your regular garbage!**
