WHEREAS, R.S.54:4-67 permits the governing body of each municipality to fix the rate of interest to be charged for non-payment of taxes or assessments subject to any abatement or discount for the late payment of taxes provided by law; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 54:4-67 has been amended to permit the fixing of said rate of 8% per annum on the first \$1500.00 of the delinquency and 18% per annum on any amount in excess of \$1500.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners, of the Township of Nutley, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to charge 8% per annum on taxes becoming delinquent after the due date, subject to any abatement or discount for the late payment of taxes provided by law.
2. Effective January 1, 2010 quarterly tax payment made by cash, check, or money order shall have a ten (10) day grace period.
3. Any payments not made in accordance with section two (2) of this resolution shall be charged interest from the due date, as set forth in section one (1) of this resolution

No. 2-10

WHEREAS, P.L. 1990, Chapter 105 supplementing Title 40 of the New Jersey State Revised Statutes has been enacted to allow a municipality the authority to impose a service charge to be added on an account which was by check or other written instrument returned for insufficient funds; and,

WHEREAS, whenever an account is owing a municipality for tax, special assessment, water, or other municipal charges, the service charge authorized by this section shall be included on whatever list of delinquent accounts is prepared for the enforcement of liens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners, of the Township of Nutley, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that the Tax Collector be authorized to charge the aforementioned fee at a rate of \$20.00 per check or other written instrument for all checks received for insufficient funds; and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Township Treasurer, Tax Collector, and Auditor.




