WHEREAS, Oral Cancer will claim 7,600 lives annually, and an estimated 35,000 new cases will be diagnosed each year; and

WHEREAS, Oral Cancer affects almost twice as many men as women; and

WHEREAS, an estimated 25% of oral cancer patients have no known risk factors; and

WHEREAS, alcohol and tobacco remain the greatest risk factors (and using them in combination increase the risk 15 times over the use of one or the other); and

WHEREAS, historically, oral cancer has been a disease of those ages 40+, but its incidence in those under 40 has been climbing and can now be directly related to the increase of Human Papillomavirus and other factors; and

WHEREAS, smokeless tobacco is not a safe alternative to cigarettes – users face a 400% greater chance of oral cancer than non-users;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Nutley, County of Essex, State of New Jersey declare April 2016 as

Oral Cancer Awareness Month

WHEREAS, Public health prevention not only educates people about the effects of lifestyle choices on their health, it also reduces the impact of disasters by preparing people for the effects of catastrophes such as hurricanes, tornadoes and terrorist attacks; and

WHEREAS, approximately 2.5 billion work days are lost due to illness every year, with an estimated fall in productivity of \$1 trillion. By improving the health of the nation, people’s lives will improve and the country will continue to prosper; and

WHEREAS, a healthy public gets sick less frequently and spends less money on health care; this means better economic productivity and an improved quality of life for everyone; and

WHEREAS, Healthy children become healthy adults. Healthy kids attend school more often and perform better overall; and

WHEREAS, Thirty-five million homes in America have at least one health or safety hazard; and

WHEREAS, Over 24 million homes have lead-based paint hazards, which put children at risk of lead poisoning; and

WHEREAS, Nearly 50 percent of Americans live in communities with unhealthy levels of air pollution associated with car exhaust and industrial pollution; and

WHEREAS, More than 23 million people in the U.S. live in a “food desert” where they don’t have access to healthy and affordable food;




