RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A PROPERTY TAX APPEAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF NUTLEY AND PB NUTCLIF MASTER, LLC

WHEREAS, PB Nutclif Master, LLC (the "Taxpayer") had acquired the property known as the former Hoffmann-La Roche site and upon purchase of the property from Hoffman-La Roche Inc., were assigned the tax appeals filed by Hoffmann-La Roche for the years of 2016 and 2017 and thereafter the Taxpayer continued the prosecution of those tax appeals and filed additional tax appeals in the year 2018 and there remains pending tax appeals under the following docket numbers constituting various block and lots constituting the former Hoffmann-La Roche property:

Docket Nos:

2401-16, 7126-16, 7155-16, 7132-16, 7140-16, 7150-16, 5362-17, 5366-17, 5367-17, 5370-17, 5371-17, 5376-17, 5377-17, 4620-18, 4624-18, 4628-18, 4631-18, 4634-18, 4637-18, 5604.18; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed to simultaneously enter into agreements entitled Settlement Agreement, Financial Agreement for the Long Term Tax Exemption-PB 100 Metro Urban Renewal, LLC and Financial Agreement for the Long Term Exemption-PB 200 Metro Urban Renewal, LLC., for properties owned by PB Nutcliff Master, LLC., c/o Prism Capital Partners, LLC (collectively, the "Agreements"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties agreement to enter into the aforesaid Agreements is contingent and conditioned upon the Taxpayer's dismissal and withdrawal, with prejudice, of all tax appeals presently pending on the property; and

WHEREAS, Taxpayer has agreed to dismiss and withdraw, with prejudice, all tax appeals presently pending for any of the lots constituting the former Hoffmann-La Roche site located within Nutley, including but not limited to those tax lots now or formerly known as Block 102, Lot 2; Block 200, Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 24; Block 201, Lot 1; Block 300, Lots 1 and 20; Block 2000, Lots 1, 4 and 5; Block 2101, Lot 1, and Block 2304, Lot 17, as shown on the official Tax Map of the Township of Nutley (collectively, the "Property") and to execute any document(s) to effectuate that purpose; and

WHEREAS, Taxpayer has agreed to forego any future tax appeals on 100 Metro Boulevard (*aka* Block 201, Lot 1.03), 200 Metro Boulevard (*aka* Block 201, Lot 1.02), and the parking garage (*aka* Block 201, Lot 1.01) for so long as the Financial Agreements are in full force and effect, and to execute any document(s) to effectuate that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Township has agreed that the assessments will be frozen for two (2) years on 100 Metro Boulevard, 200 Metro Boulevard and the parking garage pursuant to the Freeze Act.

Taxpayer acknowledges that freezing assessments does not mean taxes on those lots will not increase since the Township cannot agree to freeze the tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to enter into a Settlement Agreement with Taxpayer incorporating the terms described herein concerning the Property described herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Nutley as follows:

- **Section 1.** A Settlement Agreement by and between the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Nutley and PB Nutclif Master, LLC, concerning the Property described herein, heretofore prepared or to be prepared, in a form and with conditions and revisions as deemed advisable by the Township Attorney, is hereby authorized and approved.
- **Section 2.** The Mayor of the Township is hereby authorized to execute a Settlement Agreement and the Township Clerk is hereby authorized to attest said signature and to affix the seal of the Township unto the same, in a form and with such revisions as deemed satisfactory or necessary by the Township Attorney.
- **Section 3.** Upon the effective date of the Settlement Agreement, the Township representatives, in consultation with the Township's consultants and internal staff, are each hereby authorized to perform the obligations and exercise the rights of the Township under the Settlement Agreement so executed in a manner consistent therewith.
- **Section 4.** The Township Clerk is hereby directed to publish and post notice of this resolution as required by applicable law.
- **Section 5.** This resolution shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by applicable law.

WHEREAS, Norfolk Southern Corp. petitioned the New Jersey Department of Transportation (DOT) for the closure of the Highfield Lane at grade rail crossing to vehicular and pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Nutley strongly objects to the arbitrary and capricious selection by Norfolk Southern to the closure of the Highfield Lane at grade rail crossing in Nutley; and

WHEREAS, Highfield Lane is an important and viable roadway within the Township of Nutley serving its citizens as a major connection point between Washington Avenue (State Road Route 7) and Passaic Avenue; and

WHEREAS, there is no justifiable reason for the closing of the Highfield Lane at grade rail crossing; and

WHEREAS, there are currently no train movements on Norfolk Southern's Newark Industrial Track crossing Highfield Lane and there have not been any train movements for several years; and

WHEREAS, the closure of the Highfield Lane at grade rail crossing will divert traffic to adjacent intersections thus increasing the amount of vehicular and pedestrian traffic at those intersections; and

WHEREAS, the closing of Highfield Lane will negatively impact emergency response time for the Township of Nutley Police Department, Fire Department, EMS, EMT's and Paramedics to respond to emergency and life threatening situations in the area of Highfield Lane east of the existing crossing; and

WHEREAS, the County of Passaic will be constructing a new bridge at nearby Kingsland Street in Clifton wherein Kingsland Street will be closed for 12-18 months, thus further impacting traffic patterns in the area of Highfield Lane; and

WHEREAS, in a letter dated January 8, 2019, PRISM Capital Partners, LLC objected to the arbitrary closing by Norfolk Southern Corp. of the Highfield Lane at grade rail crossing in Nutley; and

WHEREAS, in letters dated November 18, 2018 to Norfolk Southern Corp. and New Jersey DOT, the Township of Nutley objected to the closing of the Highfield Lane at grade rail crossing in Nutley and withdrew their support for the conversion of private rail crossing's at the former Hoffman La Roche campus in Clifton into permanent public crossings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Nutley, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, that the Township of Nutley is vehemently opposed to the arbitrary and capricious closure by Norfolk Southern Corp. to the Highfield Lane at grade rail crossing in Nutley New Jersey.
