Finding #1a:

The monthly regular and bail account bank reconciliations include reconciling items from the current and prior years. In addition, new bank accounts were opened for the regular and bail accounts in April, 2017 but the old bank accounts have not yet been closed.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that all reconciling items for the Municipal Court regular and bail accounts be reviewed for proper disposition and the old regular and bail bank accounts be closed.

Explanation & Corrective Action:

There are two older accounts still open, one for the register and one for the bail. The Court Administrator is working to reconcile all four accounts, including the old ones, and close those in the next month. All reconciling items have been investigated and accounted for at this time.
