WHEREAS, 115,000 people in the U.S. are waiting for a life-saving organ transplant. Nearly 4,000 are New Jersey residents; and

WHEREAS, currently nearly 2 out of every 3 people on the waiting list are over the age of 50. There are also 2,000 children under the age of 18, and almost 70,000 people (58%) are ethnic minorities; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, more New Jersey residents gave the gift of life than ever before. Thanks to the selflessness of New Jersey organ donors and their families who said yes to donation last year, over 550 people are alive today; and

WHEREAS, every 10 minutes another person is added to the waiting list, while 20 people die each day waiting for a transplant; and

WHEREAS, one organ donor has the ability to save up to eight lives, and one tissue donor can restore health to over 75 people; and

WHEREAS, people of all ages are considered potential organ and tissue donors;


WHEREAS, April 12, 2019 has been designated as Blue and Green Day, at which time residents are encouraged to wear Blue and Green to celebrate those who have been touched by the gift of life;

WHEREAS, close to 51,550 Americans will be diagnosed with oral oropharyngeal cancer this year. It will cause over 9,750 deaths, killing roughly 1 person per hour, 24 hours per day; and

WHEREAS, oral cancer affects almost twice as many men as women; and

WHEREAS, an estimated 25% of oral cancer patients have no known risk factors; and

WHEREAS, alcohol and tobacco remain the greatest risk factors (and using them in combination increase the risk 15 times over the use of one or the other); and


WHEREAS, historically, oral cancer has been a disease of those ages 40+, but its incidence in those under 40 has been climbing and can now be directly related to the increase of Human Papillomavirus and other factors; and

WHEREAS, smokeless tobacco is not a safe alternative to cigarettes – users face a 400% greater chance of oral cancer than non-users;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Nutley, County of Essex, State of New Jersey declare April 2019 as

ORAL CANCER AWARENESS MONTH
