Recycling Guidelines

- As per New Jersey State Law and Chapter 614 of the Code of the Township of Nutley, recycling is **MANDATORY** for all property owners, tenants, residents and businesses.
- It is the responsibility of the resident to recycle according to the listed guidelines.
- Recyclables are to be placed in the correct container at the curb **no earlier than 5:00pm the night before** or **no later than 6:00am the day of collection.**
- You can help avoid missed pickups by:
 - Not placing your recyclables next to trees, telephone poles, parked cars or other obstructions
 - Having the material at the curb for collection at the proper times and in the proper recycling containers.
- Recyclables may not be placed in the street or placed in plastic bags (except shredded paper).



What Do I Do With?

ITEM	DISPOSAL LOCATION
Household Batteries	Throw <u>alkaline batteries</u> away in your regular household trash. <u>Rechargeable batteries</u> can be disposed of at Essex County's Household Hazardous Waste Day in May or October.
Flourescent Bulbs	Bring to Essex County's Household Hazardous Waste Day in May or October.
Paint	<u>Latex:</u> Residents are encouraged to remove the lid from the Latex Paint can and allow the paint to air dry in a well ventilated area (cat litter, saw-dust and shredded newspaper can be added to the contents of the can to speed the drying process). Once the paint has solidified within the container, it can be disposed of with your regular household trash. <u>Oil-Based:</u> Bring to Essex County's Household Hazardous Waste Day in May or October.
Tires	Residents may dispose of 2 tires at a time (without rims). Please call 973-284-4984 to schedule a pick up. Tires from commercial vehicles are not accepted.
Used Motor Oil	Bring used motor oil to any service station that works on cars or to the Municipal Garage.
Vehicle Batteries	Vehicle batteries can be dropped off in the designated bin at the Municipal Garage.

- All recycling should be placed curbside **BEFORE 6:00am** on your collection day.
- Commingled recycling material (cans/plastic/glass) will be picked up by F. Basso, Jr. Rubbish Removal Inc.
- Pickup times may vary throughout the day for each material collected.



Commingled Recycling

METALS, GLASS AND PLASTICS

- Aluminum and tin cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic containers with #1 thru #7 on the bottom (such as food, beverage, yogurt, detergent and shampoo bottles)

CARTONS

- Cream, Milk and Soy Milk
- Juice and Individual Juice
- Soup and Broth
- Wine

✗ COMMINGLED RECYCLING - **NOT ACCEPTED**

- Recycling containers weighing more than 35 pounds or placed in any plastic bags or mixed with any garbage
- Drinking or window glass
- Plastic shopping bags
- Flower pots
- Light bulbs
- Styrofoam
- Other types of plastics



Paper and Cardboard

MIXED PAPER

- Books
- Junk mail
- Letters and envelopes
- Magazines and catalogs
- Newspapers
- Office and colored paper
- Paper bags Paperboard (such as cereal, pizza and tissue boxes)
- Phone books

CARDBOARD

- All corrugated cardboard boxes (cut into 18 inch pieces)

SHREDDED PAPER

- Place into clear plastic garbage bags

✗ PAPER AND CARDBOARD - **NOT ACCEPTED**

- Recycling containers weighing more than 35 pounds or placed in any plastic bags or mixed with any garbage
- Paper plates, cups or towels
- Wax coated cardboard
- Soiled or food contaminated papers or cartons
- Cardboard not broken down, larger than 18 inches or with styrofoam inserts



RECYCLING IS NOT TO BE PLACED IN ANY PLASTIC BAGS (except Shredded Paper in Clear Bags)
Our Recycling Vendors WILL NOT accept your recycling as it will cause damage to their equipment



Recycling Bins are available free-of-charge

(limit one round and one rectangular bin per household)
at the DPW Garage (1 Cortland Street) weekdays from 8:30am to 3:00pm.

STORMWATER POLLUTION: WHAT DO YOU THINK?

- You may think littering is no big deal (it is).
- You may think that whatever runs into the storm drains gets treated before it reaches local rivers and streams (it doesn't).
- You may think motor oil and other hazardous materials don't harm the water (they do).

Pollution seeps into the ground and is carried by stormwater (rain and snow) directly to our drinking water, streams, lakes and oceans. Contaminated stormwater is the #1 cause of water pollution in New Jersey. Simple things, like proper clean-up after oneself and careful use of chemicals in the home, office and yard, are helpful ways for businesses and residents to protect the water.

The Township of Nutley has ordinances aimed at reducing pollution from litter, fertilizer, oil, pesticides, detergents, animal waste, grass clippings and other debris. For details, see <http://www.nutlevnj.org/stormwater-management>. Thank you for keeping them in mind and doing your share.

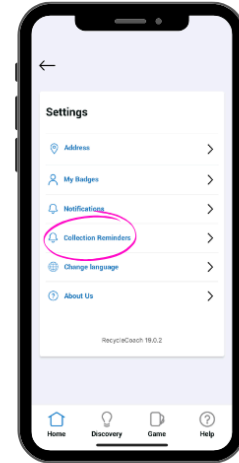

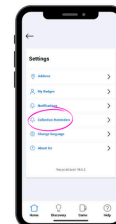
