 - Mr. Levendusky to inquire whether the Township Clerk has anything on file from the state (charter, etc.). There may also be documents held at the State Archives, perhaps an “official copy” can be produced in a commemorative manner.
 - Ideas discussed included getting a proclamation from our state representatives, doing a history walk, and having an event at the Museum.
